Property Owners will pay \$15 per each boat registered, maximum of two boats. Additional boats may be registered for a fee of \$35 per boat and must be approved by the General Manager.

To register a boat, property owners must present a current state registration card evidencing ownership of that boat to the Security Office. Security will then issue a set of numbered decals to the property owner to be affixed to the boat and trailer. The registration application will include a signed certification that the property owner agrees to abide by the DeBordieu boating rules and regulations.

A property owner may register a boat owned by a member of the property owner's immediate family; specifically limited to mothers, fathers, daughters, sons, son-in-laws, and daughter-in-laws. The property owner must request such registration in writing and must specify the relationship of the boat owner to the property owner. They must also certify that the property owner as well as the boat owner agrees to abide by the DeBordieu Boating Rules and Regulations.

If a new boat is purchased the decals must be removed from the old boat and trailer and returned to DeBordieu Community Safety before a new decal can be issued.
