



1. Only Electric Motor Scooters with a maximum speed of 15mph will be allowed.
2. Scooters allowed on roads only during following hours:

Oct. 1 st	–	Apr. 1 st	8:00 am	–	5:00 pm
Apr. 2 nd	–	Sept. 30 th	8:00 am	–	7:00 pm
3. All riders must wear helmets.
4. Scooters must be registered with DeBordieu Security and must display a “registration sticker.” In order to obtain a registration sticker, riders must provide the following to security personnel:
 - a) Scooter operator’s manual (or similar documentation from the scooter manufacturer) stating that the scooter is an electric scooter with a maximum speed of 15 mph.
 - b) Written parent permission and waiver releasing DeBordieu from responsibility for injury sustained while riding scooter.
 - c) Discussion with security personnel regarding “rules of the road” for riding scooters in DeBordieu.
 - d) Inspection of scooter by DeBordieu security to ascertain that the scooter meets DeBordieu requirements.
 - e) Proof that they are DeBordieu property owners, their children, or their parents
5. No motor scooters will be allowed on N. Wallace Pate, DeBordieu Blvd., Bonnyneck Drive, or Luvan Blvd at any time.
6. No motor scooters will be allowed in the Beach Club/Rec Center or Golf Clubhouse parking lots.
7. No motor scooters on golf course paths.
8. Absolutely no racing or pulling.
