



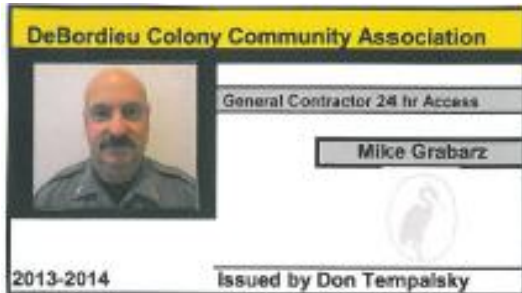
DeBORDIEU®

General Contractors. Only the GC themselves, not their employees, are authorized to access property 24/7 to; inspect an individual’s property, prepare for disaster or emergencies, secure an individual’s property, meet with a property owner or secure work sites that are currently under construction. General Contractors only will be issued a swipe card and DeBordieu ID for the purpose of accessing the property during non-commercial work hours and as a more effective and efficient means of identification.

In the event a complaint is received resulting from a GC on property after hours, it is permissible for roving patrol to perform “Community Safety Standard Operation Procedures” and report any findings to the Administration and ARB Administrator.

When a GC wishes to enter property, outside of the normal contractor hours, they are required to go through the inside lane and present a DeBordieu issued swipe card and GC ID card. An example of the card is shown below. During normal business hours they will gain access via their regular decal and barcode.

Compliance with this procedure is mandatory.
